

"Best Practice" 4 Core Perinatal Measures

Induction of labor <10%, primary cesarean <15%, episiotomy <2%, breastfeeding before discharge >75%

The "4-Core" Best Practice designation has been designed to acknowledge practices achieving nationally established benchmarks for physiologic birth. These 4 measures are harmonized with the National Quality Forum (NQF) and Joint Commission perinatal quality measures. Of the 203 practices participating in the 2011 ACNM Benchmarking survey, these 29 practices reported and achieved all four benchmarks.
