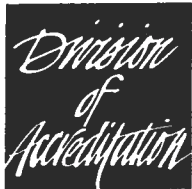

Please be advised that the American College of Nurse-Midwives (ACNM) Division of Accreditation (DOA), the recognized accrediting agency for post-baccalaureate, graduate and pre-certification nurse-midwifery education programs, took the following actions at its Board of Review meeting on June 7, 2001 in Washington, DC.
