

**Notice of Accreditation Action
by the ACME Board of Review (BOR)
Notification Date: October 9, 2020**

Accrediting agencies recognized by the U.S. Department of Education are required to notify, within 30 days of action, regional accreditors, selected specialized accreditors, regional institutional accreditors, and state licensing agencies responsible for post-secondary education regarding accreditation actions. In addition, the Accreditation Commission for Midwifery Education (ACME) also provides notice of its accreditation actions to the public on its [website](#).

Please be advised that ACME, the recognized accrediting agency for the accreditation and pre-accreditation of basic certificate, basic graduate nurse-midwifery, direct entry midwifery, and pre-certification nurse-midwifery education programs, including those programs that offer distance education, approved the following substantive changes 9/28/2020:

Substantive Change

- University of Illinois at Chicago Nurse-Midwifery program addition of a Post Graduate Certificate.
- Baylor University Louise Herrington School of Nursing Nurse-Midwifery Program changed from classroom based, face-to-face instruction to distance education.
