

**Notice of Accreditation Action
by the ACME Board of Review (BOR)
Notification Date: August 4, 2021**

Accrediting agencies recognized by the U.S. Department of Education are required to notify, within 30 days of action, regional accreditors, selected specialized accreditors, regional institutional accreditors, and state licensing agencies responsible for post-secondary education regarding accreditation actions. In addition, the Accreditation Commission for Midwifery Education (ACME) also provides notice of its accreditation actions to the public on its [website](http://www.midwife.org).

Please be advised that ACME, the recognized accrediting agency for the accreditation and pre-accreditation of basic certificate, basic graduate nurse-midwifery, direct entry midwifery, and pre-certification nurse-midwifery education programs, including those programs that offer distance education, made the following decisions during its Board of Review meeting 7/8/2021:

Continued Programmatic Accreditation

- **University of California at San Francisco, School of Nursing, Nurse-Midwifery Program**, for the Master of Science (MS) and the Post Graduate Certificate (PGC), granted a 10-year accreditation until July 31, 2031.
- **University of Minnesota, School of Nursing, Nurse-Midwifery Program**, for the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) and Post Graduate Certificate (PGC), granted a 10-year accreditation until July 31, 2031.
- **Vanderbilt University, School of Nursing, Nurse-Midwifery Program** for the Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) and Post Graduate Certificate (PGC), granted a 10-year accreditation until July 31, 2031.

Extension of Accreditation

- **University of Cincinnati, College of Nursing and Health, Nurse-Midwifery program**, for the Master of Science in Nursing (MSN), extension of accreditation until July 31, 2022.
- **Georgetown University, School of Nursing and Health Studies, Nurse-Midwifery Program**, for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing to Doctor of Nursing Practice (BSN-DNP) and Master of Science (MS), extension of accreditation until July 31, 2023.
