What's available?

- From government, federal and state
 - To education programs
 - To individuals
- From private foundations, incl. ACNM
- From schools, faith groups, hospitals and private practices



From the federal government

- Agencies that provide funding
 - Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)
 - Department of Veterans Affairs (VA)
 - Department of Defense (DOD)
 - Department of Education (Education)
- 91 programs for postsecondary education
- \$14.2 billion in 2012, 78% of it, 7 programs, for GME



Federal programs

- 60 programs provided financial assistance to support health professionals/students of varying backgrounds
- 18 programs exclusively targeted nurses, incl. APRNs
- 16 targeted to underrepresented minorities or financially disadvantaged individuals
- Grants provided to institutions, programs or individuals



Federal grants to individuals

- National Health Service Corps (NHSC) Loan Repayment Program
- NHSC Scholarship Program
- Faculty loan repayment program
- Advanced Education Nursing Traineeship



State programs for individuals

- State Loan Repayment Program
- State Education Department
